Dr. Margaret O’Gara holds the Sisters of St. Joseph of Toronto Chair in Systematic Theology at the University of St. Michael’s College, Toronto. She is a Roman Catholic scholar who specializes in Church teaching authority and ecumenical dialogue. Active in ecumenical work for over thirty-five years, Prof. O’Gara has been appointed to numerous ecumenical dialogue commissions by the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, and the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops. Prof. O’Gara has served as President of the Catholic Theological Society of America and of the North American Academy of Ecumenists. She is the author of two books: *Triumph in Defeat: Infallibility, Vatican I, and the French Minority Bishops* (Catholic University Press, 1988) and *The Ecumenical Gift Exchange* (1998).
